

THE PROPOSED CHRIST CHURCH HALL.

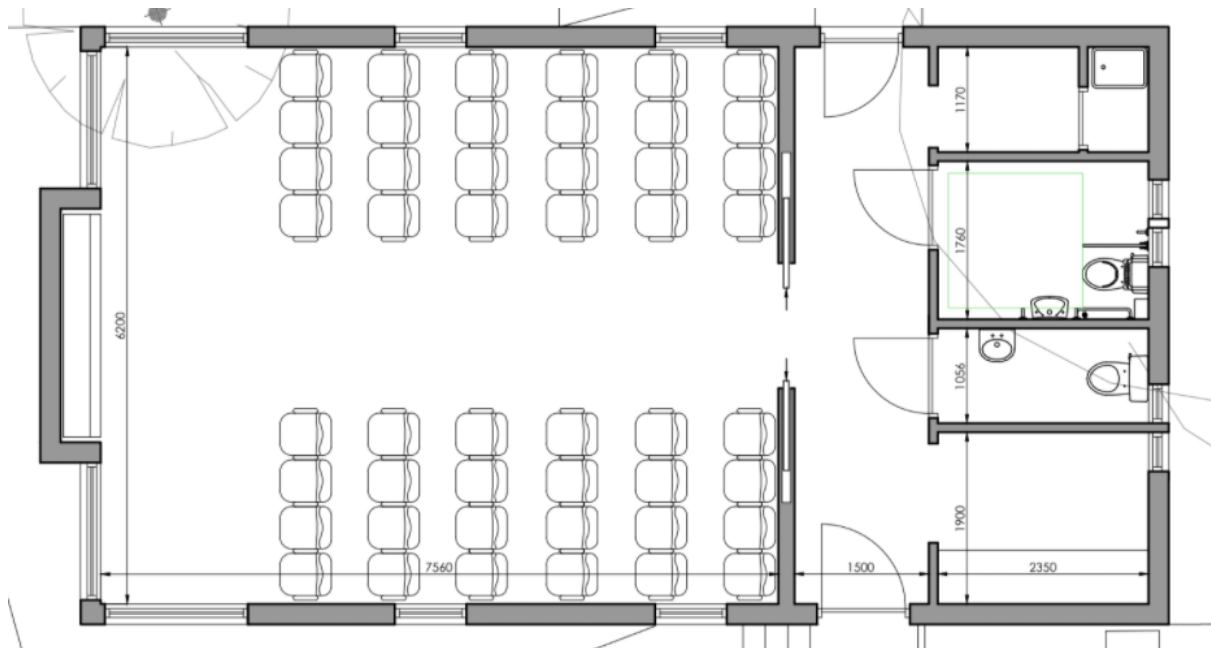
The Christ Church hall will be built in the garden grounds immediately above (north) of Christ Church and will stand separate from the church. It is expected it will seat approximately 50 people 'theatre style' or around 25-30 people at tables. It will have a small kitchen and two toilets (one with disabled access) and parking.

To give an idea of how this compares to the village hall, the Christ Church hall space is 6.2m x 7.6m and the current village hall main space is 7.3m x 14.3. The 2013 outline plan for a new village hall on the tennis court site had a main hall 13m x 15m and a side hall 5 x 10m. The current village hall will comfortably hold over 80 at tables and still leave space for some dancing and can hold over 150 people theatre style.

Christ Church will use the hall for their own business meetings, as overflow seating for busy services, for church groups to meet and for other church activities such as choir practice.

Christ Church plan to also make the hall available for use for large parts of the week both daytime and evening for a broad range of community uses including meetings, talks, cultural events, children's groups, table top sales, coffee mornings, health and wellbeing events and similar activities. Christ Church say they will make the hall available to organised community groups in the village and surrounding area, other charities and non-profit organisations, public bodies and individuals from the village and surrounding area who wish to organise an activity for the benefit of the community. They will also allow commercial activity where it is for the benefit of the community or the church. The Church Vestry may also approve use for events such as family gatherings.

For village community groups the charge for use is expected to be in the region of £10 per hour.
