

Results of Kincardine O’Neil Village Hall Consultation Exercise

The hall working group would like to thank everyone for showing interest in this project, taking the time to look at the consultation document and completing a survey form. The response to the consultation has been somewhat mixed with 70 completed.

Question 1- What do you think is the best option for a village hall in Kincardine O’Neil?

Answer	Responses	Percentage
Nothing	0	0.0%
Refurbish current hall	6	8.57%
Kirk project	0	0.0%
New hall	63	90%
Something else	2	2.86%

The comments put against the responses were quite consistent and can be easily summarised by the following remarks taken from survey replies:

- Do Nothing – Nobody backed this option or commented.
- Refurbish current hall – *“why spend a fortune on a new hall when you could refurbish the existing hall for a few thousand pounds”*.
- Kirk project – although nobody selected this option there was an interesting comment that *“A community buyout would be ideal for the church, but I can’t see that is possible”*
- New Hall – *“the current building has had its day, a bit like running a car and getting to that point where you realise spending more money on it is a waste you just have to replace it”*.
- The two “Something else” responses both suggested refurbishing the existing hall and then adding an extension which would provide a smaller meeting room, Kitchen, disabled toilets and storage.

Question 2 - Would combining hall and bowling club pavilion be acceptable?

100% of respondents replied that a combined Village Hall / Club Pavilion would be acceptable.

Question 3 - Do you like the idea of creating a village green next to the hall?

Several people didn’t answer the question but only 1 respondent was against the proposal to improve the area around the hall and bowling green.
